### From the Pastor

Every year, I look forward to buying a new Advent Calendar. I try to find one that has Bible verses behind each door, instead of just pictures. I like the Bible verses, because each day, as I open a window, I get to read a little bit of the story that leads up to the birth of our Savior.

They are familiar phrases. Usually we hear them all at once, in a big rush at the Christmas Eve service. But there is something sweet about savoring the story, piece by piece, being fed by little morsels of the dearest and most familiar of our faith stories:

*\* The angel Gabriel appeared to Mary and said, "Greetings, favored one, the Lord is with you."*

*\* Then Mary said, 'Here am I, the servant of the Lord'*

*\* An angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream.*

*\* In those days a decree went out from Emperor Augustus that all the world should be registered.*

*\* In that region there were shepherds living in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night.*

*\* I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people...*

Soon I will set up my Advent wreath too, and will light first one, then two, then three, and finally all four of the candles. The wreath is yet another way to mark the time we celebrate in the church year – waiting for the coming of our Lord. Each week, the light grows a little stronger, as the flickering flames remind us of the hope, joy, love and peace we find only in Jesus, the lover of our souls.

May your own Advent devotions draw you nearer into the heart of the mystery of our faith – as you prepare your heart and home for coming of the Christ child. God made flesh. Come to dwell with us. Love supreme.



**STEPHEN MINISTRY**


Not everyone welcomes the holiday season with joy. If you are dealing with loss, sadness, grief, stress or loneliness, the holidays can be a time of dread.

## SOCIAL MINISTRY NEWS

As the year 2011 draws to a close, the Social Ministry team would like to thank the members of Zion for your continual expressions of love and faith in support of our outreach. Sometimes, with monthly solicitations for hunger, tornado relief, Crop Walks, and Christmas gifts and so forth, our appeals may seem never-ending or overwhelming. But, it is not necessary to be a wealthy philanthropist or a full-time volunteer to make a meaningful contribution to help out in our church, community, and the world. Rather, we should give generously of whatever wealth and abilities we have, no matter how small the amount. Consider the story of the widow's mite in Luke 21: 1-4: "And Jesus looked up and saw the rich putting their gifts into the treasury. And He saw a certain poor widow putting in two small copper coins. And He said, "Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all of them, for they all out of their surplus put into the offering; but she out of her poverty put in all that she had to live on." The expression "God's work; our hands" is very relevant as we make our decisions about how to put our Christian love into action.

Zion's 120 challenge for the Oxford Food Pantry for November continues on with the collection of canned pasta. For the month of December, the item is peanut butter. We will be including boxes of mints such as Thin Mints or Andes mints with the Christmas boxes. Each package of candy will have a sticker wishing the recipient a Merry Christmas and listing the hours of Zion's services. We seek to let people know that all are, indeed, welcome.

Our annual Christmas giving trees will be placed in the narthex of the church. Gifts will be given to Worcester Project AIDS so that clients can shop in a "store-like" setting for their family members, for Oakwood Convalescent Home's elderly and disabled patients, and for LSS's Florence House for pregnant and parenting teens and their children. After you select a gift tag and shop for that person, please put that same tag on the gift when you return it. Fill out the appropriate sheet with your name and telephone number. The deadline for the Worcester Project AIDS tree is **December 11<sup>th</sup>**. Florence House and Oakwood Convalescent Center gifts should be brought in by **December 18<sup>th</sup>**.

**FINANCIAL RESULTS  
OCTOBER 31, 2011**

We took in \$10,414 thousand in October and we spent \$11,514 thousand in October. Expenses exceeded income by \$1,100 dollars-- resulting in a deficit for October

For the year, we took in \$102,920 thousand and spent \$92,794 thousand through the month of October. For the year, income exceeded expenses by \$10,125 thousand.

For the 10 months of 2011, income is \$31,366 under budget and expenses are \$41,491 under budget.


